

You DO NOT need to be an NPS member to compete in these classes!

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part breds are not eligible unless overstamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from **6**th – **8**th **August 2024**.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in August

M&M In Hand Classes

- 3. PICK UP FRONT FOOT, and hold for THREE seconds. Judge will count RIDERS DISMOUNTED for this test. Steward will help riders mount again. PONY should stand still on carpet. (10 Marks)
- 4. REVERSE pony off carpet between two cones A and B. (10 Marks)
- 5. When alongside B REVERSE around B, so facing line of UPRIGHT STAKES. (10 Marks)

General Rules for Riders and Spectators

DEFRA may require competitors to produce their horse passport at any time.

Cockington Riding Club insists that hard hats which conform to a minimum BSI standard MUST be worn, correctly fastened, by any person who is mounted whilst on the showground. Any handler under 16 should wear a current correctly standard hat in the ring.

All competitors are recommended to have 3rd party insurance.

All cars parked at owners' risk. No cars on main show field past the warm up area except committee members, blue badge holders and judges' vehicles.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times & dog poo to be cleared up by the owner and taken home.

No mucking out of lorries or trailers allowed on the show field please take it home with you.

No trotting, cantering or galloping outside rings when on the show field. Riders must leave the ring at a walk at all times.

The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry to protect the welfare of any horse/pony.

The committee reserve the right to limit entries to control class sizes. Classes may be cancelled or amalgamated if insufficient entries.

Judges names are not printed in the schedule we will aim to post judge's names to Facebook NO earlier than the week before the event (with the exception of qualifiers). However, if you are worried about being able to show under a particular judge you are welcome to contact a committee member the week before the show.

No change of saddlery allowed between phases in the Working Hunter ring. Horses/ponies may wear boots for the jumping phase.

All competitors, horses and ponies must be correctly dressed for their classes. Practising in any ring will lead to disqualification from the days events unless it's a designated warming up area.

No artificial aids for example side/draw reins. Martingales / Breastplates permitted for jumping only.

Trimming of the horses or ponies sensory hairs around the mouth, nose, eyes and ears is NOT permitted.

Horse to rider ratio. We take horse welfare seriously, size and proportionality is an important consideration to ensure the horse/pony is suitably mounted and achieve a harmonious way of going. Current research suggests horses/ponies should carry 10-20% of its healthy body weight, this includes the weight of clothing, boots, hat and tack.

The health, fitness, workload, age of the horse/pony and rider fitness, balance and ability will all have an impact, lowering the % of total weight to be carried. The focus of this guidance is equine welfare rather than rider weight.

We encourage all our riders to dismount as soon as they have finished their classes. If any spectators have any concerns over any aspect of horse welfare we encourage them to come and speak to a committee member privately.

We support our judges decision with regards to all aspects of horse/pony welfare.

Any misuse/abuse of whips/spurs at any event will result in expulsion from the venue. No whips or spurs in gymkhana rings or handy pony classes.

All Suitability, Lead Rein and First Ridden classes must be ridden in a snaffle bridle with cavesson noseband only. Lead reins must be attached ONLY to the noseband.

The committee strongly advises that competitors taking part in Jump Cross wear a suitable back protector.

Members must have paid their subscription before entering any class on day of show for points to count towards cups, or to be eligible for members' awards.

The judge's decision is always final.

Any complaints must be registered at the entries caravan and accompanied by a deposit of £20.00 refundable only if the complaint is upheld after consideration by a minimum of 3 committee members.

If competitors require rosettes/dressage sheets to be forwarded to them after the event, it is their responsibility to leave a large SAE or £3 at the caravan before leaving the show field.

Maximum of 6 classes per show can be entered per horse (not including Gymkhana or Thelwell) if this rule is not adhered to, you may be asked to leave the show ground.

Well behaved Stallions / Colts are welcome in bitted bridles but may be asked to leave if they are causing disruption to other competitors.

Entries will not be taken before 8.30am on Show Days.

Ridden horses must be 4 years of age or over on day of show. Minimum age of 4 years old for a rider (age on the day of the show.)



Tattersalls RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2025

<u>Judge - Polly Gundry.</u>

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings,

owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur.

Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the classes.

Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband.

Horses should be plaited.

The Series is open to AMATEUR riders only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration.

Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series
The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the Final.
Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting June 2025

RoR rosettes 1st – 4th and a branded prize to the winner. **The winner also qualifies** for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree on 24th August 2024.

Amateur definition:

The rules are as in the rulebook with the following addition that an amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. In addition, a person classed as amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in-kind. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season: Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in

Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity.

Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from January 1st, 2024.

Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season.

Horses and riders must not receive any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current season.

A rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

<u>Tattersalls RoR OPEN In Hand Show</u> Series Qualifier 2024

Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. - 5. Highest placed Mini rider aged under 12 years on 1st January 2023
- 6. Highest placed Junior rider under 18 years on 1st January 2023

The two highest placed ponies in each section at each qualifying show will qualify for the 2025

Final and also be eligible to be chosen to represent their Breed, NPS Area or other team in the Team Challenge which will be incorporated into the 2025 Championship Final.

Qualifying rounds are open to competitors from the UK and elsewhere. All qualifiers will receive a qualification card.

The Final will run in accordance with the 2024/2025 NPS Dressage Rules which will be available to all NPS Members.




