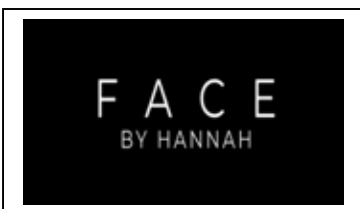

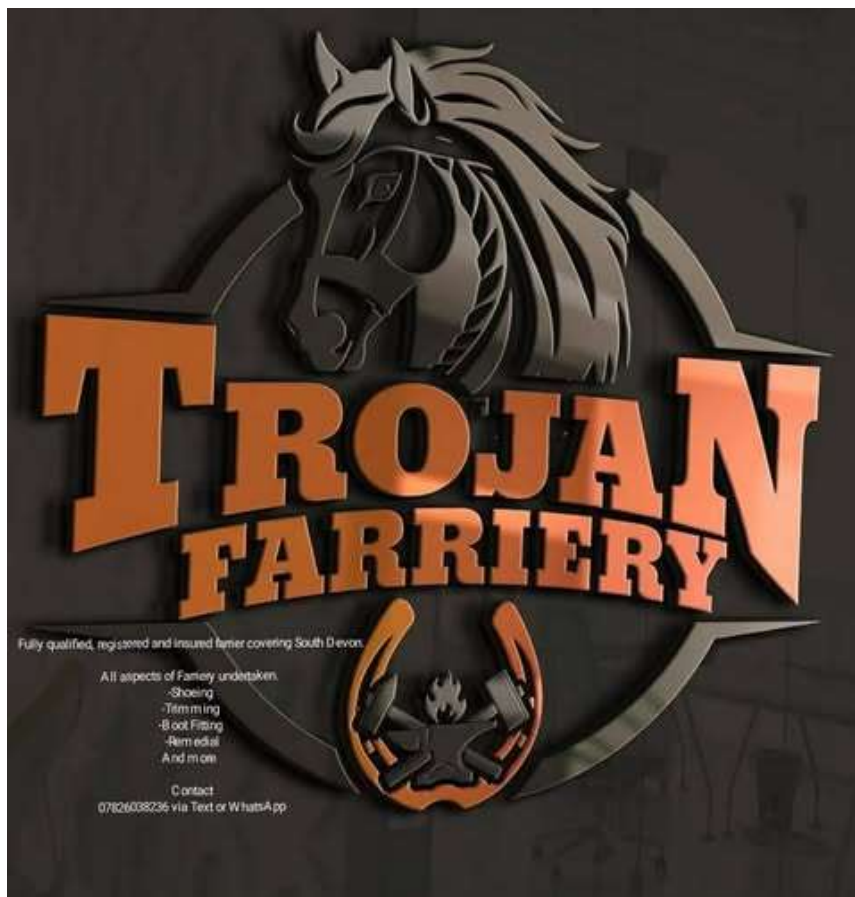

General Rules for Riders and Spectators

DEFRA may require competitors to produce their horse passport at any time.

Cockington Riding Club insists that hard hats which conform to a minimum BSI standard MUST be worn, correctly fastened, by any person who is mounted whilst on the showground. Any handler under 16 should wear a current correctly fitted standard hat in the ring.

All competitors are recommended to have 3rd party insurance.

All vehicles parked at owners' risk. No unauthorised vehicles on main show field.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times & dog poo to be cleared up by the owner and taken home.

No mucking out of lorries or trailers is allowed on the show field please take it home with you.

No trotting, cantering, or galloping outside rings when on the show field. Riders must always leave the ring at a walk.

The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry to protect the welfare of any horse/pony.

The committee reserve the right to limit entries to control class sizes. Classes may be cancelled or amalgamated if insufficient entries.

Judges names are not printed in the schedule we will aim to post judge's names to Facebook NO earlier than the week before the event (with the exception of qualifiers). However, if you are worried about being able to show under a particular judge you are welcome to contact a committee member the week before the show.

No change of saddlery allowed between phases in the Working Hunter ring. Horses/ponies may wear boots for the jumping phase.

All competitors, horses and ponies must be correctly dressed for their classes & hair must be kept of the collar & securely contained under a hat or in a bun.

Practising in any ring will lead to disqualification from the day's events unless it's a designated warming up area.

No artificial aids for example side/draw reins.

Martingales / Breastplates permitted for jumping only.

Trimming of the horses or ponies sensory hairs around the mouth, nose, eyes and ears is NOT permitted.

Horse to rider ratio. We take horse welfare seriously, size and proportionality is an important consideration to ensure the horse/pony is suitably mounted and achieve a harmonious way of going. Current research suggests horses/ponies should carry 10-20% of its healthy body weight, this includes the weight of clothing, boots, hat and tack. The health, fitness, workload, age of the horse/pony and rider fitness, balance and ability will all have an impact, lowering the % of total weight to be carried. The focus of this guidance is equine welfare rather than rider weight. <https://www.bhs.org.uk/go-riding-and-learn/stable-mates/rider-size/>

We encourage all our riders to dismount as soon as they have finished their classes. If any spectators have any concerns over any aspect of horse welfare, we encourage them to come and speak to a committee member.

We support our judges decision with regards to all aspects of horse/pony welfare.

Any misuse/abuse of whips/spurs at any event will result in expulsion from the venue. We no longer allow standard whips in any classes. No whips or spurs in gymkhana rings or handy pony classes. A baton (whip) maximum length 75cm may be used. A showing cane is permitted for showing classes.

All Suitability, Lead Rein and First Ridden classes must be ridden in a snaffle bridle with cavesson noseband only. Lead reins must be attached ONLY to the noseband. (All of ring 4 for all 3 shows)

The committee strongly advises that competitors taking part in Jump Cross wear a suitable back protector.

Members must have paid their subscription before entering any class on day of show for points to count towards cups, or to be eligible for members' awards.

Any complaints must be registered at the entries caravan on the day of the show and accompanied by a deposit of £20.00 refundable only if the complaint is upheld after consideration by a minimum of 3 committee members.

If competitors require rosettes/dressage sheets to be forwarded to them after the event, it is their responsibility to leave a large SAE or £3 before leaving the event.

Maximum of 6 classes per show can be entered per horse (not including Gymkhana or Thelwell) if this rule is not adhered to, you may be asked to leave the show ground.

Well behaved Stallions / Colts are welcome in bitted bridles but may be asked to leave if they are causing disruption to other competitors. Stallions must have a bridle disc at all times. All colt / stallions handlers & riders must be over 14 years old on the date of the show.

Entries will not be taken before 8.30am on Show Days.

Ridden horses must be 4 years of age or over on 1st January 2026.
Minimum age of 4 years old for a rider (age on the day of the show.)

The judge's decision is always **final**.

By entering, all competitors confirm that they have read, understood, and agree to abide by the TFSS Rules and the conditions set out in this schedule. The TFSS Rulebook applies in full unless otherwise stated within this schedule. In all matters of welfare, safety, eligibility, and conduct, TFSS Rules take precedence.

- Qualification is horse or pony specific and not transferable

The Judge's decision is final.

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that qualification cards are correctly completed, signed, and dated by the Judge, and that a clear copy of the horse or pony's passport identification page is submitted in accordance with TFSS instructions. TFSS accepts no responsibility for missing, incomplete, or incorrectly submitted documentation.

Horse Welfare is the overriding principle at all TFSS-affiliated competitions. The Judge, Steward, or Show Officials reserve the right to: Inspect tack, bits, spurs, and equipment at any time, eliminate competitors where welfare or safety is compromised, refuse entry to, or remove, any horse or pony deemed unfit, distressed, lame, exhausted, or unsafe.

In the interests of safety and welfare, any fall of horse, rider, or handler will result in immediate disqualification. The Judge's decision is final.

Eligibility: Horses and ponies must be four years old or over to compete in both in-hand and ridden classes, Stallions are permitted unless otherwise stated in the schedule and must be correctly registered and handled or ridden by a competent adult, Junior competitors may not ride or handle stallions Any additional eligibility requirements will be stated in the individual class description.

Tack and Equipment All tack must be safe, correctly fitted, and appropriate to the class. Training aids are not permitted in the competition ring. Any tack, bit, or equipment deemed inappropriate by the Judge or Steward may be prohibited.

Judges and Stewards All Judges officiating at TFSS qualifying classes must be members of the TFSS Approved Judges Panel. Stewards act on behalf of TFSS and have authority to enforce the Rules in the interests of welfare and safety. All judging decisions are final.

Conduct, Behaviour and Social Media Abuse of horses, officials, judges, stewards, volunteers, or competitors will not be tolerated. Unsporting behaviour, including defamatory, abusive, or inflammatory comments made online by competitors or their associates acting on their behalf, which are likely to bring TFSS, its officials, or its competitions into disrepute, may be treated as a breach of TFSS Rules. TFSS reserves the right to issue warnings, eliminate competitors, withdraw qualification, or refuse future participation.

Insurance and Liability All competitors enter and compete entirely at their own risk. By running TFSS qualifying classes, the organising show confirms that it holds valid public liability insurance.
